**RESOLUTION NO. 011-2017**  
**Adopting Issue Brief for Mobile Market PWG**

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Sustainable Food Policy Council (SFPC) is one of Denver’s Mayor-appointed Boards and Commissions; and

**WHEREAS**, one key purpose of the SFPC is to “Provide Recommendations to the City on Regulations and Policies” by identifying and recommending regulatory and policy changes that would advance the Denver Food Vision and Action Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the SFPC is tasked with providing the Mayor and city staff detailed policy analysis and recommendations that are both responsive to the Mayor/city and stakeholders by identifying interested parties, identifying pro and con arguments, identifying key stakeholders, and assessing the impact of the policy and legislation; and

**WHEREAS**, Article VI, Section 2 (f) of the By Laws allows the SFPC to designate Policy Working Groups to carry forward specific tasks of the Council for specific periods of time; and

**WHEREAS**, the SFPC created Policy Working Groups on August 16, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, per the Charter for Policy Working Groups adopted through Resolution 006-2017 on June 21, 2017 a key task of Policy Working Groups is developing Issue Briefs; and

**WHEREAS**, each Policy Working Group has met multiple times, drafted issue briefs, and shared the drafts at the regular meeting of the SFPC on October 18, 2017;

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED** that the SFPC Adopts the Mobile Grocery Retailers Issue Brief for the Mobile Market Policy Working Groups (PWG). Minor modifications will be made to standardize formatting, citations, and branding. Additional Issue Briefs may be adopted in the future at the sole discretion of the SFPC.
